For example, most local grocery stores have programs in place where we can collect points from you by just shopping there. Every time your customer card is scanned – you still receive full benefit of any sales or discounts, and none of the donation is charged to you. *However, you as the customer must take the step to designate LMC as the beneficiary of the store's donation, either at the Customer Service desk or online.* Once this step is initially taken, any purchase you make in the future will create a donation for the school.

Grandparents and friends can also help by designating their purchases to benefit LMC, and of course, greater participation means a greater benefit to the school. Boxtops for Education symbols or Campbell's Soup UPCs are easy to find on products, and can be a good project for even the youngest Lakers to collect and help their school.

LMC SCRIP Program

To assist LMC families with the cost of tuition, the following changes to the SCRIP program have been implemented.

100% of the profit earned from your participation in the SCRIP program will now be distributed as you have designated on the SCRIP Enrollment Form. This change will be retroactive to the beginning of this current SCRIP year; 4/1/08 thru 3/31/09-benefitting your 2009/2010 designation.

The new SCRIP year begins April 1, 2009 and again 100% of your earnings will be applied to your chosen designation for the 2010/2011 academic year.

PLEASE NOTE: with the above changes, all orders must be prepaid. With 100% of the profit earmarked for the families, the school will no longer be in the position to hold unpaid orders. Please plan accordingly.

The potential of the Scrip program is much greater than currently utilized. As a matter of fact, it is the only fundraising program the school offers that does not cost our parents additional money. In other words, the money you spend on Scrip is money you would have otherwise spent on needed items.

As always, orders are placed on Monday mornings by 8:30am. You may call 983-5529, fax 983-5520, or send your order with your child and have them turn it in to the office promptly.

Orders received by 8:30am on Monday are ready for distribution on Friday. Orders can be sent home with your student or picked up at either school.



Culvers of Stevensville hosts "Scoopie Nights", every third Monday of the month, from 5-8pm, where 10% of all sales that evening are donated to Lake Michigan Catholic Schools. We need volunteers that night to help with food delivery, door greeters and table cleaners. Contact Mrs. Chris Glendening if you can volunteer.

LANDS' END

Any school uniform items ordered from Lands' End will generate a donation to LMC when you designate LMC at the time of purchase. Your purchase price is not affected – the donation is given to LMC by Lands' End in support of your business with them.

Online orders - If a school uniform item qualifies, a “Preferred School Program” box shows within the item ordering description.

When you purchase Coca-Cola products, follow the steps below to help LMC Schools earn points toward educational, sports and recreational equipment. There is no need to send anything to school—simply enter the codes from your home computer.

1. Click on <http://www.mycokerewards.com>.
2. Click the “My Coke Rewards for Schools” link on the left bar.
3. Register as a member.
4. Enter codes from participating Coca-Cola products.
5. Points accumulate in your account.
6. To donate your points, choose LMC ES or HS from the list of schools on the website.
7. Invite your friends and family to help – simply refer them to the school website, www.lmclakers.org.
8. Feel free to send in your bottle tops and codes from the boxes to school and we will register them for you.



Harding's eScrip Program

Use of the Harding's eScrip Community Card will make automatic contributions to LMC when it is scanned during checkout.

1. Visit the Customer Service desk at Harding's and fill out an eScrip card application. Designate "Lake Michigan Catholic as the beneficiary of the donation.
2. Or, register online at www.hardings.com, click on "eScrip". Designate "Lake Michigan Catholic Schools".



Thanks to the Spartan Stores Apples for the Students program, we can receive computers, software, sporting goods, audio-visual aids, science items, books and other teaching tools, FREE in exchange for Spartan Stores register receipts.

When you shop at Roger's Foodland, save your receipts. Better yet, don't just save your own receipts -- ask your friends and relatives to save theirs, too! Send them to the school weekly.

Receipts from Roger's Foodland dated between September 1, 2009 and March 30, 2010 are valid.



LMC can earn up to 10% on qualified purchases at Gordon Food Service's Marketplace store. Fill out a "Fun Funds" application form (available at the elementary school and Business office) to receive your Fun Funds card. Each time you shop at GFS, have your card scanned to record your purchases towards the LMC account. GFS sends quarterly checks to our school.

Lake Michigan Catholic's Fun Funds ID number is **2033644**.



Martins provides the “Advantages for Education” program for schools, and donates points back to LMC from October to April of each school year. In turn, these points are used to purchase items for use at the school. **It’s automatic when you use your Martin’s Card, but you must take the step of designating LMC Schools as the beneficiary of the donation:**

1. Visit the Customer Service desk at Martins and complete the “Advantages for Education” form (or download one from www.lmclakers.org – in the blue left margin, scroll to “fundraising”).
2. Designate Lake Michigan Catholic (School code 4091)
3. Once registered, your Martin’s Card automatically logs a donation for LMC in addition to the normal sale savings for you. Purchases over \$79 earn double credit.



Every time you shop at Meijer, you can earn up to 4% cash back on qualified purchases for Lake Michigan Catholic. Apply for a rewards card online or pick up an application at either school. When you shop, just have your rewards card scanned at the checkout. Meijer sends a check to the school when our rewards total reaches \$100.

Each Boxtop is worth 10 cents for our school!

The Market Day program gives parents the opportunity to order restaurant quality foods and help out the school. Orders are placed once a month, and delivered to the LMC Elementary multi-purpose room on the 3rd Tuesday of every month. Orders can be picked up from 3-4pm.

If you are new to Market Day, you are in for a treat. Market Day is a collection of frozen food, some pre-cooked, some not. There are a variety of foods available including chicken breasts, steaks, burgers, fish, broccoli, corn, pastas, bread sticks, pizzas, fruit snacks, desserts, and many more. Precooked, frozen chicken or burger options with quality frozen vegetables make those busy sports evenings quick and nutritious! You get delicious food for the family and the school gets 10% of the total order.

There are two ways to place your order:

- Go online to www.marketday.com. If you are a new customer, scroll down to the new customer tab and setup your account. Then begin your shopping! Once you create an account, you can order online every month. The convenient thing about this is that you can pay by credit card online and take advantage of monthly clearance specials. (Pay by cash or check only on pickup days).

- Or, pick up an order form from either the middle/high school business office or the elementary office. Fill it out and return it to school. We'll do the rest!

Innisbrook Wraps

Innisbrook wrapping paper and products are sold in the fall by LMC students, and any orders placed online throughout the year are also credited to the school. Go to their website, www.innisbrook.com and place your order. LMC's school code is 101970.

Ink, Toner, & Cell Phone Recycling

Lake Michigan Catholic schools collect used (empty) ink and toner cartridges, and old cell phones for recycling. These items are sorted, recorded, boxed up and sent away for recycling. LMC receives payment from the recycling centers. Empty cartridges and old cell phones can be dropped off at either school for recycling.

Superbooks

When the local edition of the Superbook is printed each year, it is available for purchase through Lake Michigan Catholic schools. **LMC profits \$8 per book!** Plan on purchasing your Superbook through LMC (Business office or Elementary school) - there's no extra cost for you, and the school receives a portion of each sale as a fundraiser.
